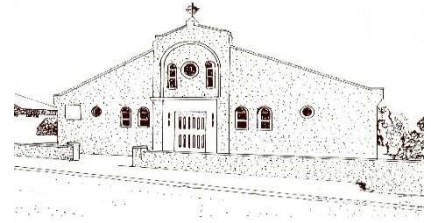

The five Lenten Gospels

The Church gives us these passages to deepen our faith on our way to Palm Sunday

First Sunday Luke 4:1-3 Temptation

Satan tries to test Jesus in the Wilderness

The faithfulness of the God-man leads the way for us in saying no to Satan

Second Sunday Luke 9:28-36 Transfiguration

On the mountain Jesus gives Saints Peter, James and John a glimpse of his true identity

We keep the vision of heaven before us to encourage us

Third Sunday Luke 13:1-9 The fall of Siloam Tower and the parable of the fig-tree

Jesus warns us that whilst God is patient, there must be no delay in repentance

We wake up to the need to root out all sin from our lives

Fourth Sunday Luke 15:1-32 The Prodigal Son

The father welcomes his youngest son back after he has turned his back on him

We ponder this incredible portrait of God to deepen our trust in his mercy

Fifth Sunday John 8:1-11 The woman caught in adultery

Jesus dismisses the sanctimonious scribes and pharisees in his tender mercy to the woman

We are called to radical self-awareness and to distinguish the sinner from the sin
