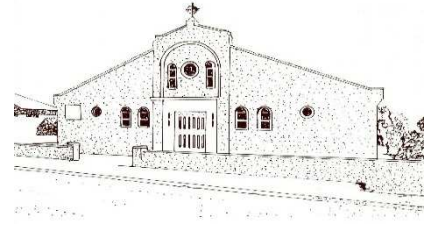

St Luke's Passion

Whilst the Passion reading on Good Friday is always from St John's Gospel, the Palm Sunday Passion is always from one of the other three gospels. So today we experience St Luke's portrait of Jesus and his last moments.

St Luke has particular themes:

Jesus' tenderness

It is only in St Luke's account that we see actually Jesus sweat blood for us in Gethsemane:

In his anguish he prayed even more earnestly, and his sweat fell to the ground like drops of blood.

The place of women

Amongst the portraits of different women, St Luke's account is of course where we hear most about Our Lady. But on the way to Calvary it is in St Luke that we have the moment when Jesus consoles the daughters of Jerusalem:

Do not weep for me, weep rather for yourselves and your children.

Persevering prayer

We often watch Jesus in prayer in St Luke's account, especially before major events. But he also exhorts his disciples – and all of us to perseverance in prayer in Gethsemane.

Pray not to be put to the test.

Mercy to sinners

In this Gospel of the parable of the Prodigal Son and the story of Zaccheus the tax-collector, we witness the response to the Good (repentant) Thief on the Cross.

Indeed I promise you, today you will be with me in paradise.
