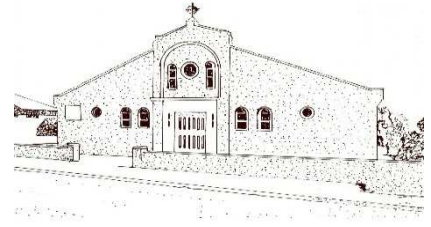

Making time to visit our churches and adore Jesus

Our two churches are open once again daily for private prayer (St Joseph's from 8am to 6pm) after painful memories of people praying outside a closed St Joseph's church during the first lock-down! Of course we can pray to God anywhere – in our rooms, whilst we walk on the beach or as we gaze at a sunset... But there is still something unique about our Catholic churches: we believe the presence of Christ is *physically real* in our tabernacles, as if Jesus had walked into the church and is standing in front of us.

Let's not take that for granted! St Pope John Paul II wrote: "Closeness to the Eucharistic Christ in silence and contemplation does not distance us from our contemporaries but, on the contrary, makes us open to human joy and distress, broadening our hearts on a global scale. Through adoration the Christian mysteriously contributes to the radical transformation of the world and to the sowing of the gospel. Anyone who prays to the Eucharistic Saviour draws the whole world with him and raises it to God."
