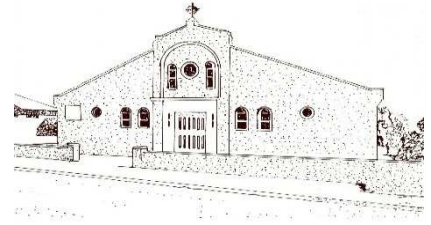

Divine Mercy Sunday: 3pm holy hour

We will have the popular holy hour once more at St Joseph's church with three o'clock prayer, chaplet, time for silent adoration and solemn blessing of Mercy Images. There will be opportunities for confession, but we encourage you to try and make your confession at the regular times during the weekend if you can to allow access to those who can only come on the day.

'I desire that this image be displayed in public on the first Sunday after Easter. That Sunday is the Feast of Mercy...

....I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to confession and receive holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to me even though its sins be like scarlet.....Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of my mercy." *From the diary of St Faustina*
