

The power of Jesus' Body – the witness of Bl Carlo

The mystery of Jesus' Body and Blood takes us not only
to the heart of our faith but right to the centre of the
cosmic sweep of creation. God uses the unfolding plan
of matter to unite himself to us and give us his own life.

Last week the mother of Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991-
2006) came to speak in London. She reminded
everyone of her teenage son's powerful love for Jesus
in the Holy Eucharist: "When you face the sun, you get
a tan, but when you face the Eucharistic Jesus, you
become holy... the Eucharist is our highway to heaven."
