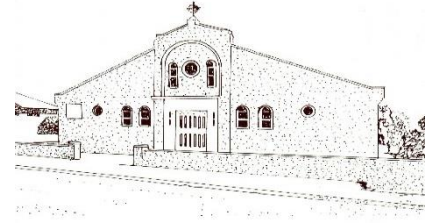

### **May our Queen rest in peace**

It seemed fitting that Her Majesty should die on the birthday of Our Lady, Mother and Queen; a final providential coda to her years of faithfulness to us all.

We can hardly add to the reflections on her life already expressed by so many, apart to thank God for her constant faith, expressed at the Millennium:

“The teachings of Christ and my own personal accountability before God provide a framework in which I try to lead my life. I, like so many of you, have drawn great comfort in difficult times from Christ's words and example.”

There will be prayers at each mass this weekend and the 10.30am Sunday Mass will be celebrated for her repose.

We pray also for His Majesty the King as he assumes his new office.

### **March for Life last Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept**

The police estimated that around 7,000 people attended the March for Life in London - to be advocates for unborn babies (and mark that 10 million have been killed through abortion in the UK since 1967).

It was encouraging to see so many young families from across the UK joyfully bringing their witness: There was a beautiful mass for Catholic marchers at St George's Cathedral before we walked across the River Thames to Westminster. The sun shone and the march was dignified and peaceful as it wound its way from the Houses of Parliament to Trafalgar Square and back again.

We plan to fill a coach next year so please come to make your voice heard.
