

The water Jesus gives welling up to eternal life

Over the next three Sundays this year we are treated to beautiful passages from St John's Gospel: the woman at the well; the healing of the blind man and the raising of Lazarus. They make up the ancient rite of the 'Scrutinies', the preparation for those received as Catholic at the Easter Vigil; each gospel passage focusses on the power of faith in Jesus and the new life he brings human beings.

These gospels also bring us all back to *our own faith*: we rediscover with awe and wonder the supernatural reality at work in us since we were baptised and our need to activate that grace through a living faith.

What's more, they remind us we *must all be apostles*. The woman at the well went back to her fellow villagers and brought them to Jesus. Let's ask ourselves: do we really believe all the people who live around us in Poole need the supernatural life only Jesus can bring?

Several people have expressed interest in the Catholic faith. If you know of any others or would just like to explore your own faith at a deeper level, we are holding a first 'Come and See' session to look at what it means to follow Jesus as a Catholic Christian: Thursday 27th April in St Joseph's Hall.
