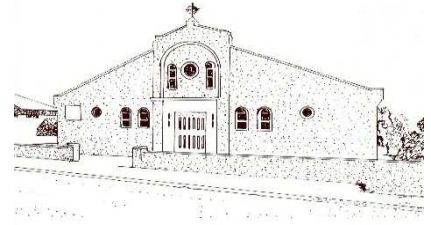

Springing back to Mass

It is encouraging to welcome so many back as you emerge from hibernation. Numbers at Sunday Mass are increasing each weekend – and at Stations of the Cross in both parishes last week were higher than we have had pre-lockdown.

In fact because our places are still limited, we must ask that if you can attend a Saturday Vigil Mass or weekday mass instead of on a Sunday morning, please do so until restrictions finally go; we have tried to avoid the need for booking at every Sunday mass, but will otherwise need to introduce this.
