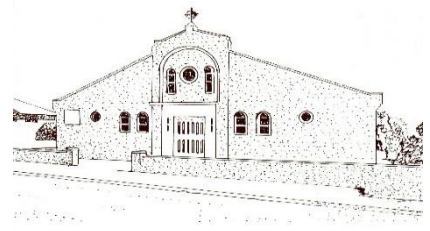

Divine Mercy Sunday

Jesus' words to St Faustina in 1936: 'On that day (Divine
Mercy Sunday) the very depths of my tender mercy are
open... The soul that will go to confession and receive
Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of
sins and punishment. On that day all the divine
floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let
no soul fear to draw near to Me even though its sins be
as scarlet.'

(This year Fr Chris leaves after Sunday Mass for his
priest's retreat so there will be no confessions on
Mercy Sunday itself this year; the Church has clarified
that confession within the Divine Mercy octave fulfils
the criterion. Sr Juliana will be leading a holy hour of
adoration and Divine Mercy devotions at Our Lady of
Fatima church, Brixey Road at 3pm on Mercy Sunday.)

Bishop Christopher Budd RIP

Rt Rev Christopher Budd was bishop of Plymouth from
1986 to 2013. He had been suffering from cancer and
died at his home in Lyme Regis on 1st April.
