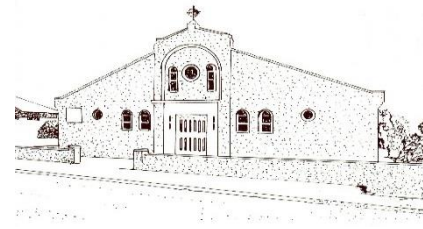

75th anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima church

Eight churches dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima have been identified in the UK – and ours seems to have been the very first. The Latin inscription on the foundation stone is dated 22nd July 1949; it was completed the following year and the first Mass was celebrated on 16th April 1950. That date falls this year on Wednesday of Holy week, so it makes more sense to have a later celebration - in May? By that time the new lighting and decoration should be complete...
