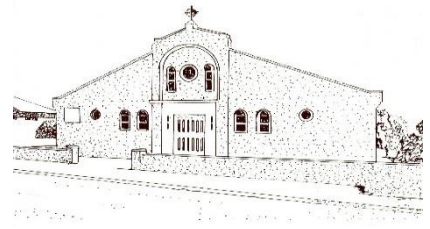

Celebrating Christ our King

This relatively new feast (1925) comes on the very last Sunday of our Church year; it sums up our faith in Jesus and looks ahead to when all will recognise Jesus' Kingship at the end of time.

This Sunday St Luke's Gospel gives us Jesus' last words about his heavenly Kingdom – as he dies below Pontius Pilate's inscription 'King of the Jews'.

We have three churches dedicated to Christ the King in our diocese: Perranporth in Cornwall; Plymouth in Devon and of course up the road from us in Kinson.

It is remarkable that so many other Christians (Anglicans, Lutherans and some other Protestants) celebrate this feast on the same day. Isn't that a pointer to us that the more we recognise Jesus' kingship, the more Christians will come together?
