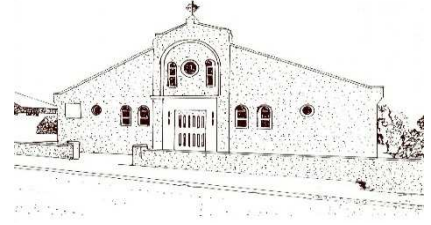

Day For Life 2021

Bishop John Sherrington ('Bishop for Life issues') writes:

"This day, inaugurated by St John Paul II, presents an opportunity ... to raise awareness of the precious gift of life and to support the work of protecting life in its most vulnerable stages through the annual collection. This assists pro-life organisations who raise awareness, engage in parliamentary work and pastoral outreach."

Against the backdrop of the extraordinary dedication of healthcare professionals in the past year "we are now faced with very real threat of the legalisation of assisted suicide in our country. It is not a question of 'if' this challenge will come; it is now a question of 'when'. There is now a Private Members' Bill in the House of Lords on so-called 'Assisted Dying' and it is only a matter of time before the issue is back in the House of Commons. The on-line resources are produced to inform Catholics about this threat to life and to share with people our response to such a threat: a true compassion is the just response to the immense value of the human person."
