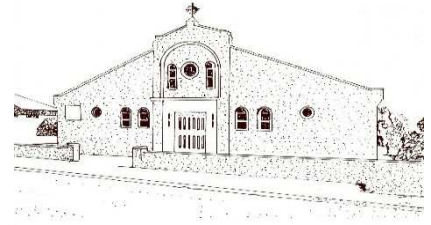

Thurs 25th Feb: Patronal Feast-day of St Walburga



As St Walburga is our patron saint we celebrate her day even in Lent as a solemnity.

St Walburga (710-779) was the daughter of a West Saxon king and was born in Devon. She was sent to school at Wimborne Abbey where she became a nun for 26 years. Her mother's brother St Boniface sent for her and her two brothers, St

Willibald and Winibald, to help him evangelise pagan Germany. She became Abbess of the double monastery in Heidenheim founded by her brother; she is depicted with the crozier – and with a bottle of the therapeutic oil that flows from her coffin (St John Henry Newman looked in to this and believed in it as authentically miraculous).

Thanks to our seminarian Andrew, this year we will have a relic of St Walburga for the parish. It was given to the him by a Benedictine monk who wanted us to have it because the parish is dedicated to her (the monastery had originally been gifted it by a religious sister). We will have this present at the Mass.

St Walburga is much loved in Germany, Belgium and the Netherlands as well as in parts of the USA. St Walburga's church in Preston has the highest steeple of any English parish church (309 feet).
