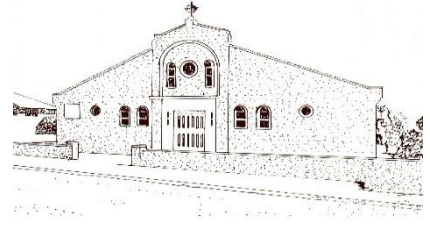

Bl Dominic – Sign of God's love for our nation

Blessed Dominic Barberi is most famous for receiving St John Henry Newman into the Catholic Church at Littlemore, Oxford 9th October 1845. But there is no doubt he was a heroic man with an extraordinary impact on so many English people during his eight years here. It's fascinating to read about his life.

In his book about the 19th century restoration of the Catholic faith in England, Fr J. Brodrick SJ wrote: "The second spring did not begin when Newman was converted nor when the hierarchy was restored. It began on a bleak October day of 1841, when a little Italian priest in comical attire shuffled down a ship's gangway at Folkestone."

An annual novena takes place this week seeking his canonisation; his mission for our country carries on...
