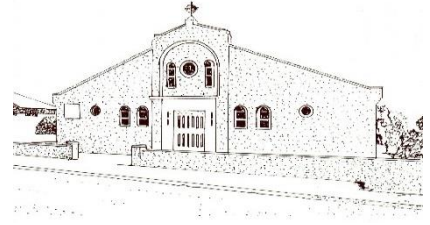

### **Sir David Amess MP RIP**

MPs' tributes this week focussed on Sir David's kindness and courtesy and the causes he championed. But it was especially moving to see an opposition MP praising the witness of Sir David's Catholic faith, going against the grain to put Catholic Social teaching into practice (his official website describes pro-life work as one of his main interests and areas of expertise).

It was noted that the police denied access to the priest who came to give the last rites: a new right-to-access for priests in such times would certainly be one positive change in Sir David's memory.
