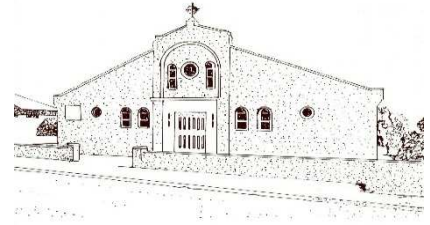

### **Coming to Mass as we emerge from lockdown**

The Sunday Mass obligation has still not been reinstated so we're still asking everyone to please attend a **weekday Mass or the Vigil Mass** instead if possible; due to rising numbers returning, we will otherwise be obliged to instate a booking regime *which we really do not want to do*.

Yes, it is one of the strangest aspects of this time to be asked *not to come to mass on a Sunday*, but we can read the Sunday Gospel at home and pray the rosary/watch the livestream to keep our Sunday special - and attend mass on another day. Please note Monday mass is at 7pm.

If we can only attend Mass on a Sunday, it is important that **we arrive at least 5 minutes before** Mass begins in order to be seated and to avoid disruption. Latecomers may not be admitted and may be asked to stay outside. That would not be ideal...

Please note that this is difficult and strange for all of us; if all goes according to plan the restrictions come to an end in only two more months. Hurrah!

**So let's be thoughtful and use our imagination;** the stewards do not have an easy task.
