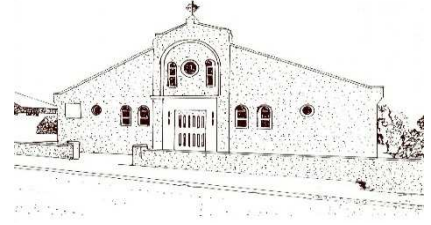

+ Coming to mass as we emerge from lockdown +

The Sunday mass obligation has not yet been reinstated so we're still asking everyone **to please attend a weekday Mass or the Saturday vigil mass instead** if possible; due to rising numbers returning we will otherwise be obliged to instate a regular booking regime *which we really do not want to do*.

Yes, it is one of the strangest aspects of this time to be asked *to avoid coming to mass on Sunday*, but we can read the Sunday gospel at home and pray the rosary/watch the livestream to keep our Sunday special - and attend mass on another day. Please note Monday mass is at 7pm.

If we can only attend mass on a Sunday, it is important that **we arrive at least 5 minutes before** mass begins in order to be seated and to avoid disruption. Latecomers may not be admitted and may be asked to stay outside; that would not be ideal...!

This is difficult and strange for all of us; if all goes according to plan the restrictions come to an end in only two more months anyway. Hurrah!

So let's be thoughtful and use our imagination until then; the stewards do not have an easy task.
