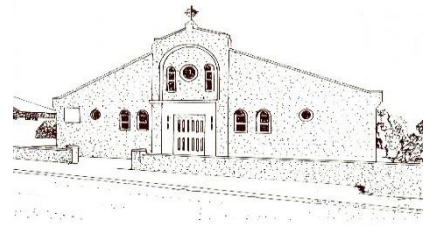

The first of our new stained-glass windows at OLF

For the centenary of the Fatima apparitions in 2017 the
parish organised a series of commemorative events and
projects. One of these was for some new windows. A
committee met regularly to decide on the designs and to
start fundraising. It chose a local company: Steve Sherriff of
Wimborne.

The first three windows are above the front door. The two
side windows show rosary beads intertwined with gold
roses: Mary revealed herself as 'Our Lady of the rosary'
calling us to pray the rosary every day to bring peace to the
world. The central window shows Our Lady's heart as it was
seen by the children - surrounded with thorns: God wanted
the world to recognise and honour that heart in its love for
us all. It also symbolises hope: Our Lady's words were "In
the end my heart will triumph and there will be an era of
peace".

The Church holds that shrines are vital places in the new
evangelization; we hope that these windows might help
draw people in a special way to God.

Four further windows for the Lady chapel depicting Our
Lady and the three children are due to arrive in August.
