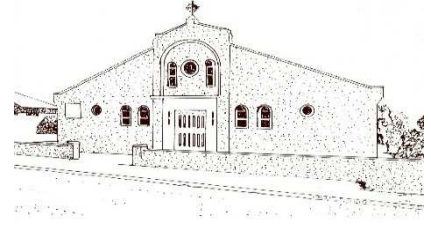

What is 'Peter's Pence'?

Once England used to lead the world in love and support for the Pope. In fact St Peter used to be our patron saint before St George was adopted. It seems it was the Saxons of these lands who started sending a fund directly to Rome over a thousand years ago; this then spread to Europe.

Today the annual worldwide collection, formalised by Pope Pius XI in 1871, is used for the Pope's charitable work and for the admin costs of the Vatican. It is usually collected on or around the feast of St Peter and St Paul on June 29th.
