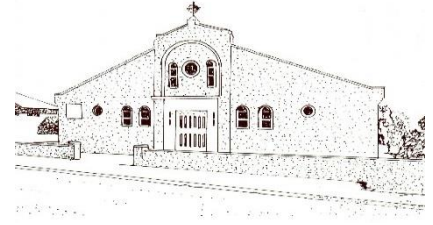

### **Which Charities should we support?**

So many charities seek our funds, all seeming to offer vital help to people in urgent need. So how do we decide which to support as Catholic Christians? The papal encyclical 'Charity in Truth' (2009) sets out all the major issues and points to what true human development means in this globalised world. 'Truth is the light that gives meaning and value to charity'. Amongst other things it reminds us that 'openness to life is at the centre of development' and that 'without a supernatural vision there can be growth but no human development'.

With the crisis of values so deep now, we find that some of the big household names will for example fund research on human embryos or work with organisations that promote abortion. Others will fund very large director's salaries or use resources on dubious political campaigns. On top of all this, human sin is always a factor. Even the pope's own charity, Peter's Pence, is up before the law courts next month for embezzling funds. So perhaps it's no wonder parish priests can be suspicious of some of the big names.

Have a look at the charity we are supporting next weekend: *Special Projects in Christian Missionary Areas*. Staffed entirely but successfully by volunteers, it aims to help those who fall through the gaps made by larger organisations. Pope Francis would surely approve.
