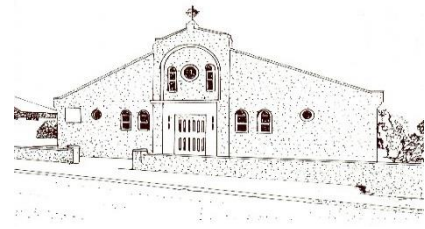

(The Church reminds us it's a grave sin to deliberately miss Mass on a holy day; something we should bring to confession before receiving Holy Communion. Why would we want to miss something so vital to us anyway!?).

Advance notice: Cancellation of Vigil Mass on 9th Nov

The Papal Nuncio has chosen a Saturday for the installation of our new bishop in Plymouth, and we've tried unsuccessfully to find another priest to say the Vigil Mass that day. The diocesan administrator has recommended that, in this instance, we ask people to attend another mass that weekend (the Bournemouth Oratory has a **vigil mass at 5pm** and St Mary's parish in Poole has a **Sunday evening mass at 5.30pm**).
