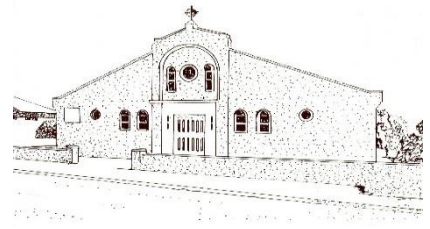

An initiative to help fix the world food system

A parishioner writes: 'Please support Pope Francis's call
to transform the food system for the benefit of people
and our planet: next weekend after Mass you will be
invited to sign an open letter written by Salina, a small
farmer in Bangladesh, to the World Bank asking it to
protect the rights of small farmers all over the world to
use and share their own seeds. Our Government is a
major donor and a most influential member of the
World Bank. If enough of us call on our UK
representatives at the World Bank to stand up for
farmers' rights to choose their own seed we can make
a difference.'

Helping safeguard Holy Communion.

Parishioners have reported seeing people take the host
away at Holy Communion, break it up and hand it to
others. This is a serious wrong.

If we see this, how should we respond? We can
approach the person calmly and point out that we've
noticed it – and that the priest has asked us to
challenge this, even if done in good faith. Holy
Communion must always be consumed immediately
and never be broken up, let alone given to infants.
