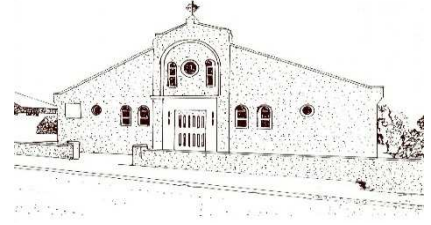

### **Celebrating Holy Week this year**

After the ban on public worship at this time last year, we can now thankfully come together once again for this most important week in our year.

The bishops, however, have ordered changes: although we will all be given palm crosses as we come into church on Palm Sunday, there will be no *outdoor procession*; on Holy Thursday there will be no washing of feet or prayer at the altar of repose; on Good Friday we will venerate the Cross in silence rather than come up to kiss it. At the Easter Vigil we will not gather outside with votive candles.

When the Passion is read on Palm Sunday and Good Friday, we are asked not to join in the parts of the crowd. All the Holy Week services including the Chrism Mass on Wednesday can be followed via [www.plymouthcathedral.co.uk](http://www.plymouthcathedral.co.uk)

Booking is essential in our two churches for the Easter Vigil Mass 8.30pm at SJ and Easter Sunday Mass at both parishes. Please note: **the Good Friday service is now full and the Easter morning Mass at both parishes is almost full.** Please call the office during office hours only or email us and give names of everyone in your party. Registration closes on **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> March at 12noon**, or before when Masses reach maximum numbers. *Please do not attend these services without a confirmed booking.*
