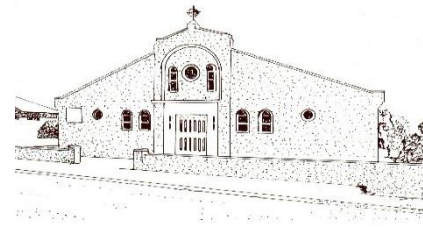

### **National Eucharistic Congress renews our faith**

Having set off at 4.30am, our seven Poole pilgrims joined the diocesan coach at Taunton to travel to Oscott in Birmingham. In all there were around 1000 clergy and faithful from across the country; we had talks, mass and a Eucharistic procession in the autumn sun around the fine grounds of the college. At the heart of our nation, where St John Henry Newman preached the 'Second Spring' sermon in 1852, our faith in the real presence of Jesus was celebrated with joy. Our new bishop-elect Philip Moger joined us for a photograph (see parish website).

### **Our parish pilgrimage to Medjugorje last week**

Despite a couple of days of unseasonal rain, our group of 18 - three Northerners joined us - had a blessed week. We climbed Apparition Hill (Podbrdo) and the great Hill of the Cross (Krizevac) as well as joining in the impressive masses and outdoor adoration hours - with 10,000 people! Fr Leon the English chaplain gave his usual strong preaching and we visited the Cenacolo community. We commended you all to Our Lady.

A couple of days after we arrived, a Vatican press conference announced that Rome had given its official approval to the spiritual apostolate of the shrine (without yet passing any judgment on the apparitions themselves which are still ongoing.)
