Being close to Jesus in Holy Week

The liturgical services this week are the special ways God gives us to be close to Our Lord in his saving work for us; we gain so much from even attending one of these.

(The Chrism mass at the cathedral on **Wednesday** is when the holy oils are blessed and priests renew their vows; this year Auxiliary bishop of Southwark Philip Moger will stand in for us).

Holy Thursday commemorates Jesus gift of his Body and Blood, the Mass, the priesthood and the command to love. We go with Jesus into the Garden to keep watch as he suffers agony for us. At 3pm on Good Friday we hear St John's magnificent gospel Passion account, pray special prayers of intercession and venerate the Cross at the time Jesus dies for us all. The vigil on Holy Saturday is our most important Mass, filled with the unique joy of Jesus' victory over death: the paschal Candle is blessed and celebrated in song; the scripture readings chart the unfolding plan for the resurrection and the Easter water is blessed - and Jesus' risen body is received in Communion.
