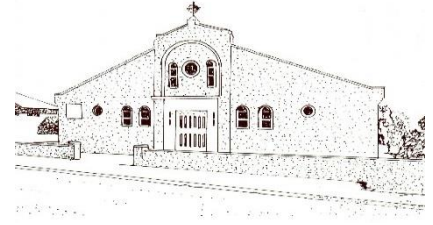

### **'Assisted Dying' Bill : 22<sup>nd</sup> October in House of Lords**

This bill seeks to allow a terminally ill adult with 'less than six months to live' to have assistance in committing suicide. It would cross another deadly rubicon in our country. Directly taking innocent life for whatever reason is always not only a very serious offence against God, it attacks the very basis of human society. If such a bill were to become law, it would also completely change the role of a doctor from that of life-saver.

Dr. Leonie Herx, past president of the Canadian Society of Palliative Care Physicians, warns "Administering death is cheaper and easier than providing care, and it will quickly become the solution for any form of human suffering, as we have seen in Canada."

Our bishops are telling us it is vital that we as Catholics stand together and fight against this; it is also a powerful form of evangelisation as we provide the good news of the alternative vision of true love.
