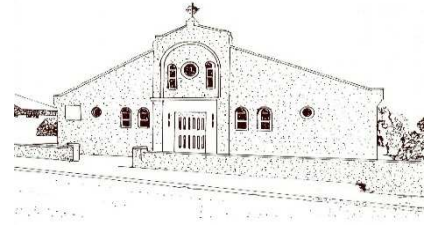

How does the Trinity connect to science?

"We're following the science" our leaders have been telling us over the past year. It is their way of saying that we will be on the safest track as a human race. As Catholics we believe that makes sense as science and reason are things God expects us to use. They even point us to God himself: "By natural reason man can know God with certainty" (Catechism 50). But we could never try to 'work God out' as though he were just another part of creation that science can explain. God is outside the world of technology and scanners. We need to him to show himself to us - and Jesus the God-man came to do that as a fulfilment of creation. He has given us the mind-blowing truth about what God is like: a Trinity - central to everything we are and do as Christians. So although the Trinity isn't something we could work out for ourselves even with 25th century science, it completes all that scientific knowledge like the sunshine finally lighting up our gloomy English Spring. We should respond with awe and joy and wonder at this amazing truth that completes and sweeps the human race up and beyond all that our laboratories do for us.
