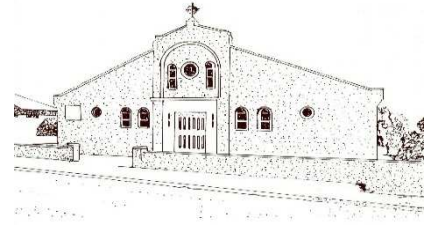

'What are these miracles? Isn't he a carpenter?'

This Sunday we watch as the people in Jesus' home town cannot accept him as Messiah, let alone as God. They have seen him beavering away in his workshop and cannot imagine such an ordinary, humble lifestyle could be adopted by the Son of God!

St Pope John Paul II said this teaches us about the importance of our work in God's eyes; that Jesus looks with love upon our human work and the different forms it takes because it is a participation in the activity of God himself, our Creator and Father.

So what does St Joseph's workshop stand for? That when we are baptised and trying to live close to Jesus in an outwardly ordinary life, God is actually there at work in us! As St Thérèse proclaimed: celebrity status means nothing to God, but a hidden life of love is incredibly valuable in His eyes.

A chance for us to protest against a deadly new law

An extreme amendment to the Police, Crime, Sentencing and Courts Bill to introduce abortion on demand, for any reason, up to birth (including sex-selective abortion) to England and Wales has been tabled by Dame Diana Johnson MP.

MPs will debate and vote on the amendment (NC55) this week.

This would be the single biggest change to abortion legislation since 1967 and would leave England and Wales with one of the most extreme abortion laws in the world.

This change to law would make the Abortion Act (1967) redundant by removing all legal safeguards (many of which protect women) around abortion provided by the Act.
