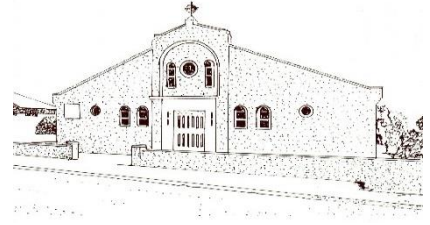

A historic moment that still points to hope

Last Tuesday the death was announced in Moscow of Mikhail Gorbachev, former Soviet Leader, aged 91.

So many of us remember the astonishing time 33 years ago when he and his wife Raisa travelled to the Vatican to meet St Pope John Paul II. They spoke in friendliness for 70 minutes in Polish, Italian and Russian. After 70 years of an extraordinarily repressive atheist regime freedom came to its people.

But did you know that 2008 Mr Gorbachev visited the tomb of St Francis in Assisi and seemed at one point to be kneeling silently in prayer? Later press statements quickly refuted suggestions that he was no longer an atheist, yet Bill Clark the US president's Catholic national security adviser kept a private dialogue going on matters of faith.

These events remind us of the unique power of our faith to prevail in ways that seem impossible by human standards...
