

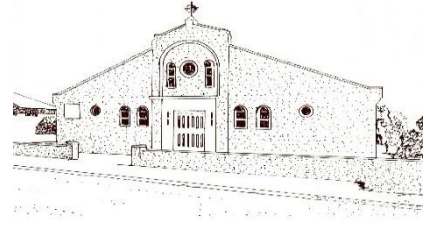

St Leo the Great (440 to 461): the 'Christmas Pope'

One of the most amazing popes in history, St Leo had to deal with a huge number of challenges, both political and religious. He somehow managed to persuade Attila the Hun not to attack Rome! He also cleverly challenged groups denying Jesus was God or that he was a true man; so he promoted Christmas day to celebrate who Jesus really is for us: *"There is no place for sadness when we keep the birthday of Life... Christian, acknowledge your dignity and by refusing to go back to an immoral lifestyle, become a partner in the divine nature!"*

His many beautiful sermons and letters are still read widely by Catholics. His feast is on Thursday.
