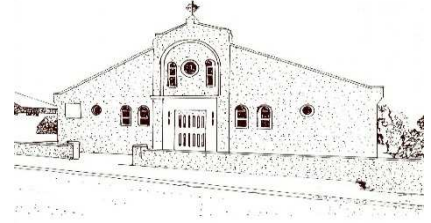

### **The Wedding at Westminster**

By now we have all discovered how our Prime Minister was able to get married in a Catholic cathedral – and that it *wasn't* 'one law for those up-top and another for everyone else'.

Even given Mr Johnson's Anglican confirmation as a teenager, his Catholic baptism made both his previous 'marriages' outside the church invalid in the Church's eyes. As a single Catholic, Carrie Symonds also had a right to be married in her parish church (Westminster Cathedral). See [rcdow.org.uk/news](http://rcdow.org.uk/news) It's worth saying (despite on-line comments) that ordinary priests *do not* automatically turn away any previously married Catholic who comes seeking marriage in the church: the priest will know full well that some previous 'marriages' might not be valid ones in the eyes of the Church and will want to look into matters more deeply.
