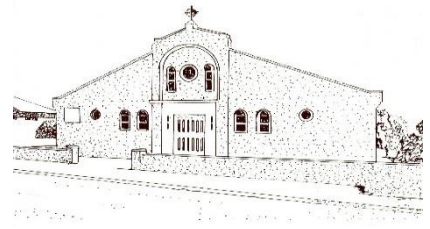

We start Mass this Sunday with the sprinkling of Holy Water to remind us of our baptism. Most of us don't remember it, but it was the day we were changed for ever. The doorway was opened to God's life in us, washing away Original Sin, making us a child of God and a member of the biggest family stretching back 2000 years and forward till the end of time. We were 'christened': made Christian and a Christian name given to us. Many Catholics find out the date they were baptised and celebrate it each year.
