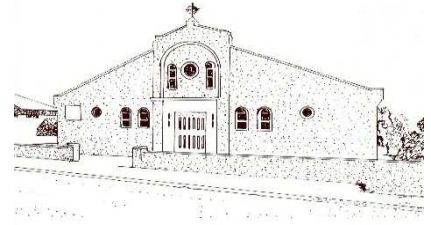

Ascension Thursday falls forty days after Easter Sunday. Holy days of obligation and Sunday obligation have not yet been re-instated, but this day is still one of our most important ones; we commemorate Jesus taking his victorious human nature beyond this world into heaven. He pioneers the way for us all, but remains with us in a new way.

Our Lady Of Fatima's feast is a solemnity in our parish as it is our patronal day. Because 13th May falls on the Ascension of Jesus this year, we are transferring the feast to Saturday 15th May. We can pray the rosary together after mass.
